

Dear Water Customer:

In 2021, the *Environmental Protection Agency* (EPA) revised the Lead & Copper Rule and is now requiring utilities to identify the service line material for all customer's waterlines. If you are a sewer only customer, please disregard this survey. Utilities have until October 16, 2024, to complete this project.

To help achieve this task, we are asking for your help. If you know what the water line coming into your home is made of, **please check the box below** and drop it off at the Town Hall at your convenience. It can be as simple as checking the material where the water line enters your residence or business. Any unidentified lines will be documented with the state and considered unknown/lead lines needing replaced. We want to work to ensure that lead does not exist in our system or your home. Being able to ensure your service line is not lead helps to protect those in your home. There are currently funding opportunities and assistance available to handle identification and replacement during this time and we are working to complete this while assistance is available.
